Warning

- This will be available from Oct 4th.
- The new firmware needs to use the new JIG SW.
 - Refurbish : dg-ps5-0021e-10-9.zip
 - SUR : dg-ps5-0051e-08-9.zip
 - MCB Repair : dg-ps5-0101e-05-9.zip

Update

- Updating system software from 1.02 is not necessary
 - Regarding TM-PS5-0133E-xx
- Inspection of M.2 SSD for MCB Repair
- Save reference number and symptom code on Serial flash
- Log file's name is added reference number

Updating system software from 1.02 is not necessary

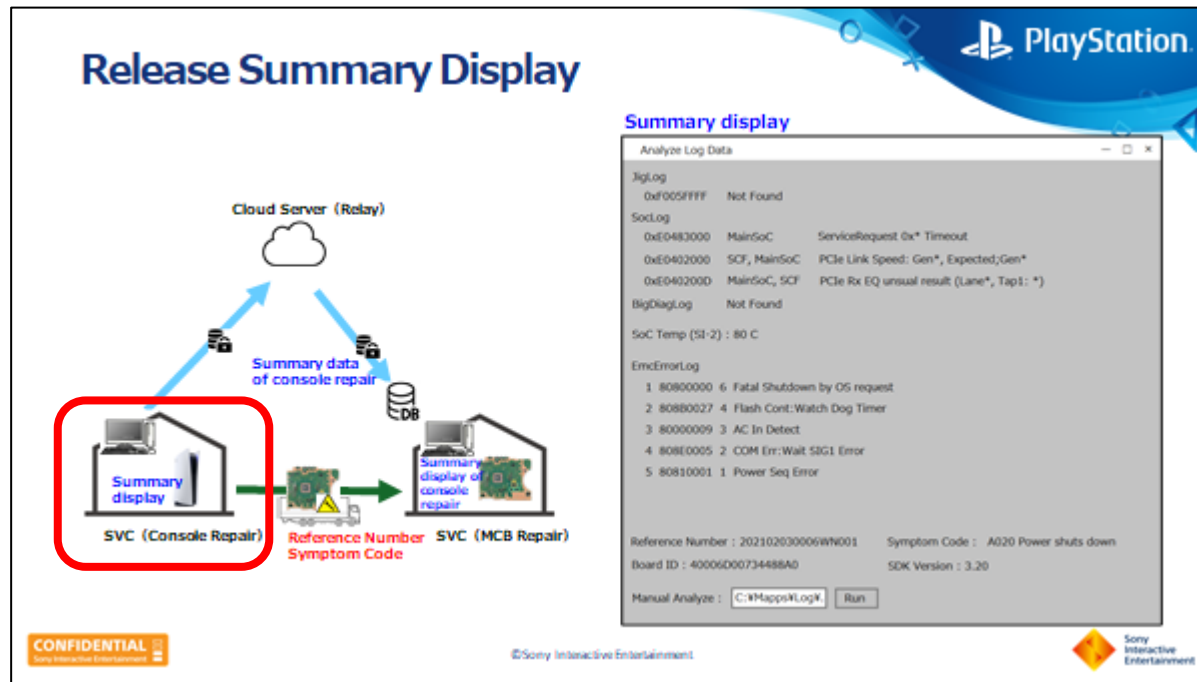
- You had to update the system software when the old MCB was exchanged for the MCB written VSH1.02.
 - Currently, the operator is turning on the PS5 in safe mode and updating the system software. (TM-PS5-0133E-xx)
- You don't need to update the system software from VSH4.00 or later.

Inspection of M.2 SSD for MCB Repair

- We introduced Inspection of M.2 SSD for MCB repair.
- This inspection is run on PI process.
- The current PI process (without M.2 SSD) still exists.
- Please choose either one depending on the situation.

Save reference number and symptom (1/3)

- This feature will be introduced as the first step for Summary Display.



Save reference number and symptom (2/3)

- GetInfo/Getlog was changed some operations.
 - The version without the reference number has been deleted.
- You should input the reference number and symptom code.
- This procedure will not work if the console is not 4.00 or later.
 - You update system software before when you want to know the reference number in other processes.

Save reference number and symptom (3/3)

- This information is also output text in a log file.
- Please open the JigLog file and search for a reference number or symptom code.
 - Keyword : “ReferenceNumber” and “SymptomCode”

Log file's name is added reference number

- The saved reference number is used as a part of the log file's name.
- You can also know the reference number in the log file for each process.
 - Before : JigLog-[BoardID]_CSDISI_00000_01_YYYYMMDD_HHMMSS.log
 - After : JigLog-**Reference#**_[BoardID]_CSDISI_00000_01_YYYYMMDD_HHMMSS.log
- You can link some log files with this name.
